GYAN ANANT VIDYALAYA (GAV)

As a continued approach towards creating awareness about family planning in districts of Bahraich and Barabanki of Uttar Pradesh, the Mobius Foundation with the support of Impact Communications, are providing contraceptives to the ASHAs of the villages. The ASHAs further distribute the contraceptives to the married couples and parents to maintain spacing between children. The contraceptive giveaway consists of 2 Mala D boxes and 1 N. Deluxe box as shown in pictures.

MOBILE HEALTH CAMPS

Mobius Foundation in support with its implementation arm, Sustainable Advocacy Team for Human Improvement (SATHI) has organized health

camps in villages of Sonipat. The health camps are organized annually to create awareness of healthcare and hygiene among students, youth, women, and farmers. The Mobius Foundation plans to organize 48 health camps round the year. In the month of October this year, 297 patients were treated through mobile health camps in 5 villages, Bandh, Kaith, Buana Laku, Gangana and Israna through self-help groups (SHG).

AFFORESTATION MAINTENANCE

Dodabette Peak Area, Pushpagiri Ranges - Kodagu District, Karnataka

During lockdown and subsequent monsoons, maintenance (in the form of manure, dweeding, and fencing maintenance) couldn't be carried out. During the period 02 to 04 Nov 2020, the manuring and dweeding of the saplings was undertaken. Also a physical count of the saplings which survived was undertaken, A total of 3616 saplings have survived. Another 175 bamboo saplings were planted. It was noticed that there was cattle ingress taking place from two gaps. Both these gaps were fenced. Also tourist/locals had damaged some posts and loosened the barbed wire in places. These were repaired/replaced. During Jan 2020 the tourist had set fire to the dry grass which spread due to winds. Dweeding of sapling pits which was undertaken just prior to this incident prevented any major damage to our saplings. In order to prevent such a re-occurrence, a fire lane was created. It was also seen that Nirale and Nelli species have grown much better than the others.
